EQUIPMENT CARE

Never push the equipment beyond its design limits. If it will not do what you want with reasonable ease, assume you have the wrong equipment for the job. Contact your local HSS Hire Shop for advice.

Keep the equipment clean, you will find it less of a chore if you clean it regularly rather than wait until the end of the hire period.

When not in use, store the equipment somewhere clean, dry and safe from thieves.

FINISHING OFF

Dismantle the assembly, simply reverse the erection procedure and then give everything a final clean, ready for return to your local HSS Hire Shop.



GENERAL SAFFTY

New Health and Safety regulations, introduced in early 1997, have placed certain limits on the maximum safe working height and the minimum platform width of a work platform.

For advice on the safety and suitability of this equipment contact your local HSS Hire Shop.

There is a serious risk of personal injury if you do not follow all instructions laid down in this quide.

This equipment has been designed to be used by an able bodied, competent adult who has read and understood these instructions. Anyone with either a temporary or permanent disability, should seek expert advice before using it.

Keep children, animals and bystanders away from the work area.



Never use this equipment if you are ill, feeling tired, or under the influence of alcohol or drugs.



Wear sensible clothing, gloves and comfortable footwear offering good

grip. If necessary, wear a hard hat.



The Super Board Staging is very heavy. Never attempt to lift it on your own, always get help.

Don't attempt to use access equipment unless you feel comfortable working at heights.

Never use access equipment unless there is someone within sight to summon help in the event of accident.

Never carry equipment while climbing unless you can do so leaving your hands free, by carrying the equipment in a shoulder bag. Climb first then haul the equipment up after you on a rope.

Never use access equipment near over-head or wall mounted power cables and similar hazards.

Check the equipment's condition before use. If it show signs of damage or excessive wear return it to your local HSS Hire Shop for replacement.


Never use the equipment in very windy or blustery conditions.

The max safe working load of all HSS Super Boards is 270KG evenly distributed. The total weight of the user and tools must not exceed this.

Never use chairs, boxes etc. to gain extra height.

GETTING STARTED

The Super Board can be used on trestles, tower scaffold and traditional tube and clip scaffold. For the purpose of this quide it is presumed that the hirer is using trestles to support the board. The instructions are the same regardless of the supporting equipment.



Always set up the equipment on a firm, level, and non-slip surface. On soft ground, stand the trestle on boards to stop it sinking in.

Place the Super Board on the trestle at the height required, ensuring that it is placed centrally on the rungs. Have an able-bodied assistant to help lift the Super Board into position.

Ensure the Super Board rests securely on the trestles, with both ends extending at least 300mm beyond the rungs.


GUARDRAILS...

Guardrails should always be used at a platform height of 2 metres and above.

Use the safety ties provided to secure the Super Board to its trestles.

Clamp the Guard-rail uprights to the Super Board (see illustration), not more than 2.4m apart. Ensuring that the bolts are fully tightened.

Clamp the rails to the uprights, one to the top and one midway, ensuring their ends do not extend more than 300mm beyond the outer uprights.



Finally, clip the toeboards to the bottoms of the uprights, so they face in towards the Super Board.

Loosen both wing nuts and open the couplers two jaws, close the jaws around the hand rail and the support
