

GENERAL SAFFTY

For advice on the safety and suitability of this equipment contact your local HSS Hire Shop.

There is a serious risk of personal injury if you do not follow all instructions laid down in this guide.

The hirer has a responsibility to ensure that all necessary risk assessments have been completed prior to the use of this equipment.

This equipment should be used by an able bodied, competent adult who has read and understood these instructions. Anyone with either a temporary or permanent disability, should seek expert advice before using it.

This equipment is designed as a cordoning off barrier only, it is not suitable as a crowd restraint. If in doubt contact your local HSS Hire Shop for advice.

Check the condition of the equipment before use. If it shows signs of damage or excessive wear, return it to your local HSS Hire Shop.

GETTING STARTED

Check that you have enough units to for the area to be covered. Each unit is fitted with a 4 metre retractable tape.

Take the barriers to where they are being used and position as necessary.

Where the post has been removed from the base, simply screw the post into the base, turning clockwise.

With each unit in position, fill each base with water to weigh it down. Open the filler cap, fill with clean water and replace the cap firmly.

If using the barrier in freezing conditions, leave a minimum 30mm air gap between the water and the top of the base.


The fitting on the end of the tape has a slot set in it, which engages with a receiver clip on the top of the next post.

All that remains is to pull the tape from one barrier and slot its end onto the next one.

EQUIPMENT CARE

Never push the equipment beyond its design limits. If it will not do what you want with reasonable ease and speed, assume you have the wrong tool for the job. Contact your local HSS Hire Shop for advice.

Keep the equipment clean – you will find this less of a chore if you clean it regularly, rather than wait until the end of the hire period.



When not in use, store the equipment somewhere clean, dry and safe from thieves.

FINISHING OFF

Dismantle the barriers and empty the water from each base.

Give each unit a final clean up ready for return, to your local HSS Hire Shop.
